Scripted / Automatic Firing	YES Fire manually or automatically using a script loaded from a USB memory stick. Ideal for automatic shows or pyro musicals.	NO Manual firing only.
Continuity Checking	YES Shows continuity information even if multiple modules bonded to same channel and cue i.e. overlapping modules.	YES Shows continuity only if modules do not overlap i.e. all modules have separate channel and cue.
User Firmware Update	YES User can update module firmware wirelessly for future proofing modules.	NO User can not update firmware without return to manufacturer.
